

2023 Lesson Pricing and Information

- **Tiny Tot Lessons** are 30 minutes in duration; lesson time on and off the horse is scheduled based on the individual child's focus and stamina and will vary. These lessons are conducted with one-on-one instructor attention but are planned in a setting with at least one other rider (with another individual instructor) to enhance the experience.
- **Beginner Lessons** are 30 minutes in duration and start with equal amounts of grooming and riding. Beginner riders start in a private session and are moved to a group once they are evaluated as safely able to ride in this setting.
- **Group Lessons** are 45 minutes in duration. They will start with arriving 15 minutes ahead of your riding time to groom and tack your horse. These lessons are for 2-4 riders with the same skill level or riding goals. The focus is on basic horsemanship skills, skill-building technique, and ring strategy.
- **Private Lessons** are 30 minutes in duration. These lessons are tailored to the individual's specific needs and include lunge lessons or show prep.

- Package Expiration 4-lesson packages expire 45 days after purchase; 8-lesson packages expire 90 days after purchase.

- **Riding Attire** recommended riding attire is riding jodhpurs, riding boots, riding gloves, and helmets. After one-month of riding, riding boots are **required** to continue riding.
