Employee Appreciation questions are a set of questions to help you as the manager better understand what appreciation looks like to the employee. Some employees like to be publicly appreciated; others want to a quiet thank you. What's critical is understanding what each one wants to feel appreciated and valued.

• Why do you need one?:

Understanding appreciation helps the leader understand what's important and ultimately helps increase engagement and lower attrition.

• How do you use this one?:
