Field Trips

We are so excited to offer field trips again during out Summer Program. Field Trips help us enhance the learning environment as well as offer something fun for our students to enjoy. We do not charge any extra for field trips, however, we do require that students maintain proper behavior while on field trips.

Field Trip Guidelines

- 1. Students who attend a field trip must have signed permission from a parent and a parent or guardian must fill out any required forms requested by the venue, when applicable.
- 2. Students must follow all directions given by the teachers and group leaders while on the field trip.
- 3. Students must remain in their designated group.
- 4. Students must conduct themselves in a way that is consistent with the expectations of Shoreline Learning Center. This includes their actions and their speech.
- 5. When on a field trip, students are expected to leave minimal impact on places visited. This includes placing all trash in the proper receptacles, staying on designated paths and in designated areas, and only touching and using items and/or exhibits when granted by the venue and per the venue's rules.
- 6. While traveling, students must follow all safety guidelines set by the federal, state, and bus charter agency (when applicable).

I understand that my child's field trip attendance is dependent on their ability to follow guidelines set forth in this document. I understand that my child may be blocked from further field trips, suspended from the program, and/or removed from the program if any of the following behaviors occur:

- 1. Any activity that inhibits the venue from performing normal functions.
- 2. Vandalizing or damaging transportation vehicles, venue structures, venue exhibits, or any other property belonging to Shoreline Learning Center, Shoreline Church, transportation services, or venues.
- 3. Any violent act or threats of violence including actions toward staff, students, venue staff, or the general public while on venue grounds.
- 4. Behavior or actions that compromise the safety of a student's self, other students, transportation service, or venue guests and staff.
- 5. Using language that is offensive, racist, sexual, or inappropriate determined by Shoreline Learning Center behavioral guidelines and at the sole discretion of the center.
