Board Certification for Pediatric Dentistry

Choosing a dentist for your child can feel overwhelming. While family or general dentists serve all ages and can provide good care, they do not have the specialized training in pediatric specific dentistry. Pediatric dentists are certi-

fied by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry (AAPD) which means they complete at least two years of specialized training after dental school, working solely with children in both clinical and hospital settings.

A board-certified pediatric dentist works with children daily, and their entire staff is trained to meet children's needs. Not all "kids' dentists" are board-certified pediatric dentists, so verify the dentist's qualifications and their experience working with children.

Child-Friendly Staff and Fun Atmosphere

Some pediatric dentists may let you visit prior to your child's first appointment. Ensure that the office offers a comprehensive range of services for children, including kid-friendly amenities like a comforting environment and options for treatment including sedation dentistry to ease dental visit anxiety, if needed.

Observe the office environment, cleanliness, and overall atmosphere. A welcoming office can reduce your child's anxiety. A compassionate team can significantly enhance your child's comfort during visits. Skilled dental professionals can help

build trust and create a positive dental experience. For some of my patients who have special healthcare needs, such as patients diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder, I allow them to come in for friendly visits between regularly scheduled ones to come say hello. It's a great time to help build our relationship and to make more positive experiences.

An Emphasis on Preventive Care

Discuss preventive care with your pediatric dentist including routine cleanings, dental sealants, fluoride treatments, and other protective measures. Preventive pediatric care helps avoid issues like tooth decay and promotes healthy oral habits as your child grows. Education should be a part of the regular visits so that these topics can be understood and implemented at home for lasting health.

This is crucial for regular visits, especially if your child needs orthodontic care, which requires frequent appointments. Consider the hours of operation and whether you can schedule appointments over the phone or via text during office hours or even after hours. Restoration of Rett Reef

Aims to Revitalize Galveston Bay's Oyster Harvest



The Texas oyster harvest has concluded following another challenging season, but hope is on the horizon for Galveston Bay. A significant restoration effort, led by Prestige Oyster company and Pier 6 Oyster House, is underway to revive a damaged reef in San Leon. This initiative, named Rett Reef, not only aims to highlight the ecological importance of oysters but also raises awareness for Rett Syndrome, a neurological disorder.

Nearly 400 tons of oyster shells are being deployed on a private 10-acre reef just offshore. These shells, collected by Pier 6 Oyster House since 2020, will serve as the foundation for new oyster growth and a habitat for various marine life. The original reef was devastated by Hurricane lke, which deposited massive amounts of sediment, smothering the oyster beds.

Public oyster reefs in Galveston Bay have struggled due to environmental challenges and overharvesting. The restoration project, in collaboration with the Texas A&M Sea Grant and The Nature Conservancy, aims to demonstrate the vital role oysters play in the bay's ecosystem. Oysters filter water, protect shorelines from erosion, and provide habitat for other marine species, contributing significantly to the bay's health.

The process of rebuilding the reef involves blasting oyster shells into the bay using water cannons, creating a bed for new oysters to attach and grow. The crew ensures the shells are evenly distributed by steering the boat in precise patterns. Once placed, new oysters will begin to spawn almost immediately, attracting other marine life and gradually restoring the ecosystem.





Prestige Oysters and Pier 6 Seafood and Oyster House have committed to making Rett Reef a non-harvestable sanctuary, serving purely as a habitat for marine life and a site for sport fishing. The initiative marks a pioneering collaboration between private industry and public conservation efforts in Texas.

The project's success will be closely monitored by scientists and volunteers, who will track the health and growth of the new oyster population. The hope is that this model can inspire similar efforts, demonstrating how private industry and conservation can work together to benefit both the environment and the economy.

Lisa Halili, co-owner of Prestige Oysters, has long understood the importance of maintaining healthy oyster reefs. Her vision for Rett Reef began in 2016, driven by her extensive experience in the oyster industry and a deep commitment to ecological sustainability. Alongside her husband, Johnny Halili, and their nephew, Gezim Halili, the family has been instrumental in collecting and repurposing oyster shells to create a sustainable reef.

Oysters are crucial to coastal ecosystems, acting as natural water filters and protecting shorelines. The restored Rett Reef is expected to contribute significantly to the overall health of Galveston Bay, setting a precedent for future restoration projects. The collaboration between industry and conservationists serves as a beacon of hope, showcasing the positive impact of sustainable practices in preserving natural resources for future generations.







20-foot BANANA SPLIT PARTY

ick off the summer with our unforgettable 20-foot banana split party in the park! We started this tradition when my boys were little, and it's become a yearly highlight ever since. The preparation is key, but seeing the joy on the kids' faces as they gaze at the enormous sundae makes it all worthwhile. This delightful treat not only adds fun to summer gatherings but also serves as a spectacular centerpiece, especially during Fourth of July celebrations. Join us to create lasting memories and enjoy the festive atmosphere!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

For the trough:

• 1 carpet tube, 1 sheet of 1/8" MDF or Masonite, jigsaw, tin foil, tape, and plastic table covers.

For the Banana Splits:

 15 bananas, 7 tubs of ice cream, assorted toppings (sprinkles, chocolate and caramel syrup, whipped cream, maraschino cherries).



INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: Obtain and Prepare the Tube

 Visit a carpet store and ask for a carpet tube (about 8-10 feet long). Use a jigsaw to cut the tube in half. If needed, use the second half for a larger setup.

Step 2: Prep the Tube for Serving

• Wrap the half-tube in tin foil and secure it with tape at the bottom to make it food-safe.

Step 3: Pre-scoop Ice Cream

 In the morning of the event, pre-scoop the ice cream onto a cookie sheet layered with wax paper. Store these in the freezer on separate layers to prevent sticking.

Step 4: Assemble the Sundae

 Set up the trough on the plastic table covers and secure with tape before guests arrive. Slice bananas and prepare toppings. During the event, assign 2-3 people to add ice cream and toppings quickly. Have someone distribute spoons and ensure toppings are ready to use. Aim to assemble within 4 minutes to prevent melting.

Step 5: Enjoy and Clean Up

Enjoy the banana splits for about 10-20 minutes before it melts, which might lead to a playful food fight.
 Afterward, recycle the used materials and hose down any mess.




